- Student Contracts & Grading: Students signing up for ASB are on a SEMESTER basis and will be expected to read, sign, and uphold a contract agreeing to maintain the standards expected of all ASB representatives. Failure to follow contract guidelines (including teamwork, attendance, support, school spirit, etc) may result in removal from the elective.
- Class Representatives: ASB will have two people from each class serve as representatives in ASB. Class Representatives will serve as the voice for their other class members, promote school-related activities, and will boost school pride and spirit in their peers. Class Representatives are obligated to the semester they are enrolled and Rep' positions will be up for renewal/replacement at each new semester mark.
- Officer Positions: The positions of President (12th grade), Vice President (11th or 12th), Secretary (11th or 12th), and Treasurer (12th) are open **only** to individuals who served in ASB the previous year. Students in an officer position must go through an election process and will be expected to not only uphold the same standards of each member of ASB, but to be leaders of the elective for the duration of the school year. **\*Due to COVID-19, ASB Officer positions are currently closed for the 2020-2021** school year.\*

Responsibilities for the elective include but are not limited to:

- Attending a <u>minimum</u> of two school sponsored events (dances, movie nights, sporting events, etc.)
- Assisting with setup and breakdown of events

[ ] Class Representative: Class Representative positions are available to **two** members from each class (freshman, sophomore, junior, and senior). Class Representatives will only be contractually obligated during the semester that they sign up for (fall or spring). Students choosing this elective will undergo an application process prior to being accepted for the role. <u>Please use this link to apply</u>.

During the Class Representative's serving semester the responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Attending and being active members for every Tuesday, Wednesday\*, and Thursday meeting
- Actively participating in every school spirit week that takes place during this time
- Attending a minimum of four school sponsored events that take place during this time
- Assisting with setup and breakdown of events
- Promoting a positive school environment (ALWAYS!)
